Policies, Registration & Tuition 2011-2012 School Year

REGISTRATION: All BDTS students must have a completed registration form and signed "waiver of liability" before beginning class. There is a yearly registration fee of \$30 (not adults). Please note: a mid-year withdrawal will incur a new registration fee upon enrollment.

REFUNDS, CHANGES AND WITHDRAWALS: Tuition and registration fees are non-refundable. Tuition is paid in advance of class participation. Should there be the need to withdraw, the registrar must be notified in person and in writing at least one week prior to the start of the next billing cycle (1st of the next month) **REFUND POLICY SHOULD BE CLEARLY UNDERSTOOD. THERE WILL BE NO REFUND OF TUITION ONCE PAYMENT HAS BEEN MADE UNLESS THE REASON FOR WITHDRAWAL IS A SERIOUS DISABILITY AND IS ACCOMPANIED BY A PHYSICIAN'S CONFIRMATION LETTER.**

MISSED CLASSES: Students may "make-up" missed classes by attending any other class at the appropriate age and skill level. NO CREDIT IS MADE TOWARD TUITION FOR CLASSES MISSED. Missed classes may not be used in lieu of tuition for the next payment period and full tuition is owed on each payment period regardless of classes missed in a prior month. Classes missed due to an inclement weather closing can be made up. Students who need or want to "take off" for whatever reason and for whatever time period are expected to withdraw from the class. Re-enrollment in the class will incur a new registration fee and is dependent on space in the class. BDTS will not "hold" a space in a class unless the customer agrees to a continuation of tuition.

PAYMENT OF TUITION AND FEES: Tuition does not change whether we have long months or short months tuition is based on the school year divided into 9 payments. The first payment is due prior to the first class and then on the 1st of each successive month. Payment by "autopay" is preferred in which a debit is drawn from your Credit/Debit card on the 1st of each month. "Non-Autopay" customers may use check, cash or credit card but will pay for **3 months tuition ahead**. Payment of a registration fee of \$30 is due at the time of each enrollment. Please note that a \$20 fee will be added to your tuition if it is paid late. A \$25.00 charge will be added for returned checks.

CLASS CANCELLATION: Classes with fewer than 5 students are subject to cancellation and/or consolidation.

LATENESS AND ETIQUETTE: Being late for class is very distracting to the teacher and other students. Those who are more than 15 minutes late may not be allowed to participate (we are aware of the fact that it is usually not the student's fault if he/she is late. It is, however, still very distracting). Perpetual lateness may result in a student being asked to leave a class. Other distracting behaviors in class are also not acceptable (e.g. Talking with each other, chewing gum, yawning, sitting on the floor, hanging on the barre, etc.)

DISMISSAL: Disruptive behavior may result in a student being asked to sit out a class. On very rare occasion a student may be asked to leave the school. Bullying, name calling, hitting or punching will not be tolerated. This dismissal is not grounds for refund of tuition.

CLOTHES, HAIR AND ATTIRE: Proper hair and attire is not a suggestion or a request. All students will be expected to comply with the dress and hair code for all their classes. This includes clothing, hair and jewelry. Hair should be worn off the neck in a neat bun and done well before class begins. Jewelry must be kept to a minimum. Please see the dress code chart for the correct attire for each class.

SHOWCASE: The Spring Showcase Concert is performed at the end of the school year. Children will begin rehearsing their pieces as part of their class beginning in March. Attendance to class is especially important during this time until the concert. When a child misses classes it becomes very difficult to rehearse the piece and all the children attending class suffer. When a child drops out of the concert unexpectedly, the instructor is forced to reset the piece which everyone must re-learn. We strongly encourage families to make a firm commitment to attendance especially during this time. The week prior to the concert is devoted to groups rehearsals and regular classes schedules are suspended. Costume fees for parents/students who do wish to participate will be announced in November and usually do not exceed \$50.00. There is no "recital fee". The only other charge that occurs relating to the showcase is the cost of your seat at the auditorium (usually Reynolds Theatre at Duke University)

CONSERVATORY LEVEL CLASSES: The following classes are considered to be Conservatory Level Classes at BDTS in which the students have extra requirements regarding attendance and behavior: **Ballet 3 through Ballet 6, Musical Theatre 1,2 and 3, Jazz-Adv and Tap-Int.**

Consistently poor attendance and disregard of the dress and behavior code will result in dismissal from the class.

SPRING CONCERT: The Spring Concert occurs at the end of the school year. In class rehearsals begin sometime in March. Attendance during this period is especially important. Costumes deposits of \$25 are due Dec 1, 2011. The balance is due at receipt of costumes. There are no other recital fees. Your only other costs will be for seats at Reynold's theatre. The week before the Spring Concert, regular classes will be cancelled in leau of group rehearsals.

ADULTS: Adults (or teens 18 or more) do not register for class. Adultd pay for classes with a "FLEXCARD" which allows them to take any adult class except Zumba. Adults are not allowed in youth classes.
